## **Key Competencies**

A Passionate Educator with a Long Track Record of Success: Patrick served as the Director of Guitar Studies at Weaver Academy for Performing and Visual Arts in Greensboro, North Carolina USA, a full-time tenured position from 2005 until he relocated to Singapore to accompany his wife. With over forty years of teaching experience, Patrick has taught private guitar lessons, guitar classes, guitar ensemble, mixed ensemble, basic musicianship and music appreciation courses. His students have won more than three hundred awards across the United States, including three prize winners in the Guitar Festival America Youth Division, a semi-finalist in the James Stroud Classical Guitar Competition and, a feature artist on From the Top, a prestigious radio and TV program on the National Public Radio and PBS. Many of his students have gone on to successful careers as professional musicians, including a Grammy-winning producer. But most importantly, Patrick is proud to have taught and mentor many wonderful individuals. At the height of Covid, Patrick, along with Interlochen Arts Academy, the pre-college division of Eastman School of Music and his former institution, Weaver Academy developed the online program called "Three School, Three States and Three Classes' which offered online performances and masterclasses with world-class artists.

A Deep Understanding of Guitar Pedagogy and Tradition while staying current with Today's Research and Development: Patrick studied under Aaron Shearer, known as the Dean of America's Classical Guitar. He was one of the very few full scholarship students of this legendary guitar pedagogue. Under Aaron Shearer's influence, Patrick has kept an open mind and continues to research and stay up to date with the latest development in his field. As a result of his accumulated knowledge, he presented the lecture, "Reimagining the Classical Guitar Education for a Complete Musician" at the Guitar Foundation America's Educator Hour and in the Columbus State University Guitar Symposium in 2024. Patrick also recognizes the advancements in technology and their importance. In 2016, he created the YouTube channel Weaver Academy StairwellSessions and maintained it until he left his position in June 2024. During this period of time, he has produced 267 videos for Weaver Academy for Performing and Visual Arts. Additionally, he has a YouTube channel of his own.

Keeping Up with His Own Craft: A celebrated performer in his own right, Patrick continues to perform both as a solo recitalist and an ensemble player. He is currently on tour in the United States, giving solo recitals and masterclasses at Appalachian State University, East Carolina University and in the Queen's University of Charlotte Guitar Symposium. He recently completed his recording titled Obras Sentimentale. The first album, which features both famous, and lesser known Spanish composers is now

in the queue to be released on CD Baby. The second album, featuring lesser-performed Italian and Mexican Composers, is set to be released three months. A physical CD will be available soon.
